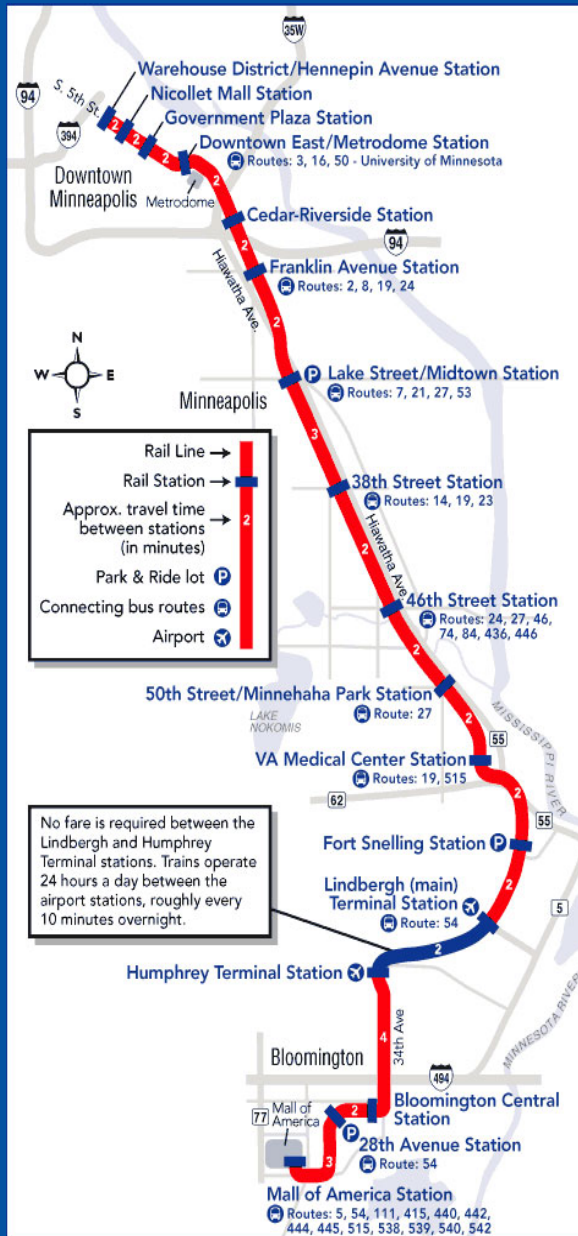
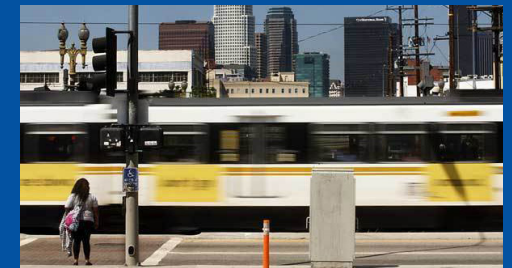

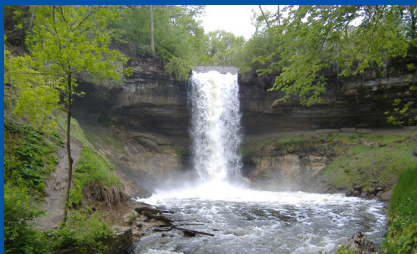
## Mall of America Station
